Short Stay Unit Opens at Windsor Regional Hospital

Windsor Regional Hospital is pleased to announce the opening of a new short stay unit. Located on 5North, the new unit will provide care for patients who have medical issues that can be addressed quickly to return them to their own home in a timely manner. The unit has 16 to 20 beds. A program called WELLcome mat provided by volunteers will be piloted on the unit to provide orientation to newly admitted patients. Congratulations to all for helping to launch this new unit.

The annual Operating Room summer closures will occur from July 29 through August 11, 2013— similar to OR shutdown at Ouellette Campus. This is for all elective surgical cases; however, one OR room remains ready for emergency cases.
