Hospital Report Released

The 2007 Hospital Reports for Acute Care, Emergency Care, Rehabilitation and Complex Continuing Care were released last week. WRH made significant progress in Acute Care, Rehabilitation Care, Complex Care and the Emergency Department. Under System Integration and Change, both Healthy Workplace and Patient Safety, Reporting & Analysis achieved a perfect 100% score compared to the Provincial average at 73.8%. Windsor Regional Hospital was one of only two Hospitals in the Province to earn a 100% score in this area. In addition, we scored 84.2% for Overall Impressions of patients in the Acute Care Program. This score was above the provincial average. Our score for Communication, Consideration and Responsiveness was also above Provincial averages. For more information, visit www.oha.ca.
