The **Employee Referral Award Program** is a recruitment program that encourages and compensates current Windsor Regional Hospital employees for referring qualified candidates to selected employment opportunities. An employee is eligible to receive a one thousand (\$1000) dollar cash award for the referral and hiring of a candidate.
