Physician Assistant Joins Emergency Department Staff

Windsor Regional Hospital hired its first Physician Assistant (PA), Albert Massaquoi who began working in the Emergency Department of the Met Campus on January 2, 2010 under a two year contract agreement. The Ministry of Health and Long Term Care provides 75% of the salary costs for Physician Assistants. Physician Assistants are members of the health care team who assist physicians in providing a broad range of medical services. Historically, PA's have been employed by the Canadian military to assist members of the military and their families. Albert will work in close collaboration with Dr. David Adekoya, Deputy Chief of the Emergency Department (ED) regarding the management decisions of patients.
