This past week Windsor Regional Hospital was granted the highest status – **Accreditation with Exemplary Standing** - a recognition handed out to very few. Organizations are evaluated based on their performance against many national standards of excellence and required organizational practices for quality and patient safety. Accreditation Surveyors spend close to a week onsite at an organization, reviewing documentation and performance data, observing care processes, interviewing patients, families, Staff, Physicians, and Community Partners. Windsor Regional Hospital publicly announced its commitment to regional comprehensive men's health in 2010. Last September, the Ontario Government committed to paying the annual operating expenses estimated at \$2.5 million, a critical first step in turning our vision into a reality.
