NEONATOLOGIST LOCUM TENENS **NEONATAL INTENSIVE CARE UNIT, DEPARTMENT OF PAEDIATRICS,** **WINDSOR REGIONAL HOSPITAL**

The Neonatology program, Department of Paediatrics at Windsor Regional Hospital (WRH) is seeking locum neonatologist to join its dynamic multidisciplinary team of 4 neonatologists, 2 NNPs, nurses, neonatal dietitian, neonatal pharmacist, and other allied health professionals to help provide clinical care to patients.

The Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU) at WRH is a large 22 bed Level IIC/ Modified III Unit that provides care to babies over the gestational age of 26 weeks and serves a population of 400,000 in Windsor and Essex County of South Western Ontario. With over 3800 in-hospital deliveries every year, we see around 500 NICU admissions, half of which are preterm. Due to the growing needs of the region, the NICU program is in the process of drafting an ambitious expansion plan which will coincide with a major reform of the Windsor-Essex Hospitals System and construction of a state-of-the-art acute care hospital in the next decade (<https://www.wrh.on.ca/AbouttheProject>).

In addition, Windsor is the site for one of the two campuses of the MD program and one of two clinical teaching units (CTU) of the Pediatric Residency program of Schulich Medicine, Western University (www.schulich.uwo.ca). The members of the NICU program also work closely with members of the Departments of Pediatrics and Obstetrics & Gynecology in clinical, teaching and research activities. Furthermore, Windsor NICU is a member of both the Canadian Neonatal Network and Canadian Neurodevelopmental Follow-up Network for reporting and benchmarking, working collaboratively to improve clinical practice and outcomes.

The locum tenens can pick up to 74 locum days each fiscal year, with an option to renew. The locum tenens will start as soon as an appropriate candidate is identified.
