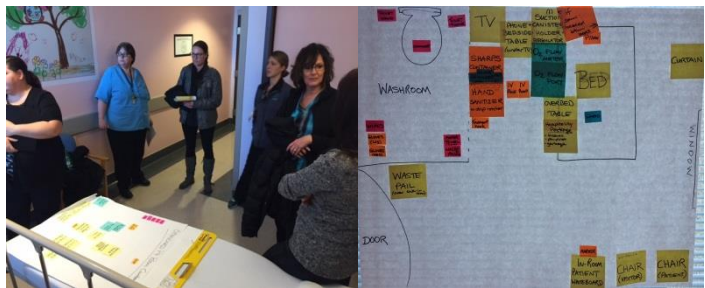


## *ED to ICU Transfer Process – Early Results*

Beginning the week of December 14<sup>th</sup>, the SOP Critical Care Team worked with its partners at both campuses to standardize the process of transferring newly admitted patients from the Emergency Department to the ICU. At both campuses Critical Care nurses are testing the process of traveling down to the ED to pick up their patient. Early results are very promising. Over the past two weeks, the average ED to ICU time has decreased at both campuses. For the week of December 28<sup>th</sup>, the Met campus averaged 79 min and the Ouellette campus averaged 45 min; both within the provincial target of 90 min. Testing will continue in order to align each step of the process. Stay tuned!

## *Standard Room Set Up*

The Standardized Unit project team along with housekeeping and infection control representatives devoted time this week to develop a standard patient room set-up. Decisions were made related to “what” and “where” items would be located in the room upon admission, along with “who” is accountable for the tasks. The design session occurred at the MET campus and the same will be replicated at OUL on Friday. The project team will be testing the standard room set-up in the coming weeks for feedback.
