Sickle cell disease is the most common
inherited red blood cell disorder.

It affects the shape of red blood cells,
causing them to become hard and
sickle-shaped. This can block blood flow
to organs and tissues, leading to **serious**
health complications.

KEY FACTS

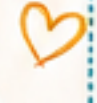
-  Affects **~3500** people in Ontario.
