

NURSING STUDENT CHECKLIST

CLINICAL PLACEMENT

Your Clinical Placement at WRH

- 1. **Advanced Police Clearance WITH Vulnerable Sector Check**
 - Must be dated within 1 year of orientation date.
 - Required **ONCE** for your entire career as a student with WRH
 - Bring **original AND photocopy** to “Volunteer Services” department.
NOTE: There are no photocopy facilities on site.

- 2. **Pyxis Tutorial**
 - Complete tutorial from school, print certificate and give to Instructor

- 3. **“Pyxis ID/Password Assignment Information Pertaining to Nursing Students”**
 - Print this form, sign it and give to Instructor.

- 4. **Health Clearance**
 - Health Clearance includes **up to date immunizations and TB skin test** as well as **N95 Mask Fit Testing**.

- 5. **Confidentiality Statement/Agreement**
 - Every student must print and sign this agreement. Bring this signed agreement to the volunteer services department to be handed in with your police clearance.
 - Required **ONCE** for your entire career as a student with WRH

- 6. **“WRH Check for Understanding” (Required YEARLY)**
 - View the Internet site of Windsor Regional Hospital at: <http://www.wrh.on.ca> and follow these links:
 - Programs and Services – choose **Research and Education**
 - Click on **Nursing Students Homepage**
 - Read necessary content modules yearly & click on the link next to **Post Test**
 - Complete the post test and submit answers.

 - View the Internet site of Windsor Regional Hospital at: <http://www.wrh.on.ca> and review the following:
 - “About WRH” – review interesting facts about WRH
 - Location of the shuttle parking lot for the Metropolitan campus and print off the map (NOTE: Students are expected to use the shuttle parking. Student Parking is not allowed in the Visitor’s Parking Lot)
 - Health Sciences Library – hours of operation and resources available to nursing students
 - Cafeteria services at both campuses.

It is understood that any and all students who have not completed their registration documentation before the first day of their clinical rotation will be removed from the clinical area. There will be no exceptions to this rule.
